

FACTS	WHAT DOES CONSTANT CASH DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?	
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.	
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect, and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Social Security number and income ▪ Account balances and payment history ▪ Credit history and credit scores ▪ Employment Information <p>When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>	
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Constant Cash chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who is providing this notice?	Plain Green, LLC d/b/a ConstantCash, is a wholly owned limited liability company of the Chippewa Cree Tribe of the Rocky Boy's Reservation, a federally recognized tribe and its affiliates as listed below.
What we do	
How does Constant Cash, protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Constant Cash, collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Open an account or apply for a loan ■ Give us your income information or provide employment information ■ Give us your contact information We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness ■ Affiliates from using your information to market to you ■ Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Our affiliates include companies that are owed by a common parent company.</i>
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Nonaffiliates we share with can include direct marketing companies.</i>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Our joint marketing partners may include program managers for stored value cards.</i>
Other important information	
<p>"Do not track": When someone visits the ConstantCash website, a cookie is placed on the visitor's computer (if the visitor accepts cookies). The cookie we place on your computer does not contain any of your personally identifiable information. ConstantCash advertises its products and services on websites that you may visit, and ConstantCash uses service providers to place such advertisements. Those service providers (such as Google, Microsoft or Yahoo) may use cookies placed on your computer to show you advertisements for ConstantCash services on other websites.
